The venue on the grounds of 'the Hamburg Slaughterhouse', an abattoir, purpose built a hundred years ago, is now a place of continuous change and houses artists and designers, working next to the more traditional meat and food businesses.

The theme of change runs through the exhibition also: each of the days has a different motto - 'early morning fog', 'solstice' and finally 'forest mumurs' (with guest DJ Q6) - thus creating different moods and leaving new impressions.
